The first two papers of this issue are part of the special issue of *computational complexity* containing archival versions of papers that appeared in preliminary form in the proceedings of the 19th Annual IEEE Conference on Computational Complexity (CCC 2004), held on the campus of the University of Massachusetts in Amherst, MA, June 21-24, 2004. The program committee of the conference, chaired by Russell Impagliazzo, selected some of the conference papers for inclusion in special issues of *computational complexity*, to represent the high quality and breadth of research presented at the conference.
