## Correction to: An appraisal of critical effect sizes for the benchmark dose approach to assess dose–response relationships in genetic toxicology

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In the original publication, Table 1 was incorrect (differences in the numerators of the fractions). The correct version of Table 1 (sums in the numerators) is given below.

**Table 1** Formulas used to estimate CES

Nr	Name	Formula	Data
1	CESISD <sub>study</sub>	$\frac{\bar{x}+sd}{\bar{x}} - 1$	Mean and standard deviation (sd) of the concurrent study
2	CESISD <sub>hc</sub>	$\frac{\bar{x}_{hc}+sd_{hc}}{\bar{x}_{hc}} - 1$	Mean and sd of all historical control (hc) data in a lab
3	CESISD <sub>thc</sub>	$\frac{\bar{x}_{hc}+sd_{thc}}{\bar{x}_{thc}} - 1$	Mean and sd of hc data after excluding the uppermost 5% data points (trimmed mean and sd)
4	CESIMAD <sub>hc</sub>	$\frac{\bar{x}_{hc}+mad_{hc}}{\bar{x}_{hc}} - 1$	Median and median absolute difference of all hc data
5	CESISD <sub>WBhc</sub>	$\frac{\bar{x}_{hc}+sd_{WBhc}}{\bar{x}_{hc}} - 1$	Based on all hc data. $sd_{WBhc}^2$ depends on the within and between study variances: $sd_{WBhc}^2 = sd_{within}^2 + sd_{between}^2$
