- In the original it read: ‘They were instructed to use a scale from 1 to 4 where 1 = “clearly visible”,

2 = “pretty visible”, 3 = “I saw something, but I don’t know which way the line was tilted” and 4 = “I did not see anything.”’

- It should read: ‘They were instructed to use a scale from 1 to 4 where 1 = “I did not see anything”, 2 = “I saw something but I don’t know which way the line was tilted”, 3 = “pretty visible” and 4 = “clearly visible.”’
