In Discussion section, fifth sentence of the first paragraph on p. 75 should read as:

In particular, given that the Participant in Nature orientation positively influenced norms and behavior,

management agencies that tailor communication strategies to address the co-dependence of people and nature, will be more likely to align with the existing worldviews of anglers included in this study. Our results also indicated that managers should emphasize the physical, emotional, and spritual bonds formed between people and places given that respondents who held these beliefs were less likely to respond to social pressure, and in turn, take action that would minimize the spread of AIS.

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
