News from IFIP – Technical Committee delegate openings within the Swiss IFIP Committee (SIC)

As the Swiss member of IFIP, SI appoints its delegates to the various IFIP bodies: the General Assembly and the Technical Committees. These delegates are appointed for a period of 4 years renewable by periods of 2 years. Invitation for Nominations

TC 10 (Computer Systems Technology). Nominations are open for this position of Swiss delegate to TC 10 Computer Systems Technology.

AIMS of the Committee:

- promotion of the State-of-the-Art,
- coordination of information exchange on concepts, methodologies, and tools in the stages of the life cycle of computer systems.

SCOPE:

- system and component concepts, architecture and organisation,

- specification, design and verification methodologies of computer systems,
- logical design and fabrication of components and systems,
- evaluation of the parameters of computer systems and components,
- reliability,
- assessment of emerging technologies,
- application specific computer systems and components including peripherals.

TC 10 has four Working Groups:

- WG 10.2 Embedded Systems,
- WG 10.3 Concurrent Systems,
- WG 10.4 Dependable Computing and Fault Tolerance,
- WG 10.5 Design and Engineering of Electronic Systems.

TC 13 (Human-Computer Interaction). Nominations are open for this position of Swiss delegate to TC 13 Computer Systems Technology.

AIMS:

- to encourage development towards a science and a technology of human-computer interaction,
- to promote the use of knowledge and methods from the human sciences in both design and evaluation of computer systems,
- to develop guidelines, models and methods by which designers may be able to provide better human-oriented computer systems.

SCOPE:

- the problems people have with computers, the impact of computers upon people in both individual and organizational contexts, the appropriate allocation of tasks between computers and people, harmonising the computer to the characteristics and needs of the user, etc.

TC 13 has nine Working Groups in areas like: Education and curricula, Methodology, Disability, Children, Reliability and Safety, International Development, etc. Details at <http://www.ifip.org>, TC 13.
