crest derived cells in the hirschsprung's disease mouse model". The Michael Hollwarth Clinical Research Prize was awarded to Dr Christian Tomuschat for his presentation on "reduced expression of voltage-gated Kv11.1 (Herg) K+ channels in Aganglionic Colon in Hirschsprung's disease".
