The author would like to point out that the correct transcription for the Tlingit phrase for sustainability (right hand column on p. 4 para 2, lines 3–4 in the original version) should be "woosh eetix" not "wooch.ee tix". The correct sentence should read: Going "with nature" on the other hand meant enhancing the integrity and productivity of life through cultivation techniques that sustained life, "keeping it living," or in Tlingit, woosh eetix' [?] ("[keeping them] growing behind each other [i.e.,replacing each other]," according to elder Clarence Jackson, pers. comm.).
