In the original publication, the first sentence in the “Findings” section was incorrectly published as “To improve statistical power, I pool evangelical Protestants and Roman Catholics; coefficients reflect intercepts for evangelicals, as all models include a dummy variable for Roman Catholic affiliation.”

The correct sentence should read: “To improve statistical power, I pool evangelical Protestants and Roman Catholics; the models imply a different intercept for evangelicals, as I include a dummy variable for Roman Catholic affiliation.”
