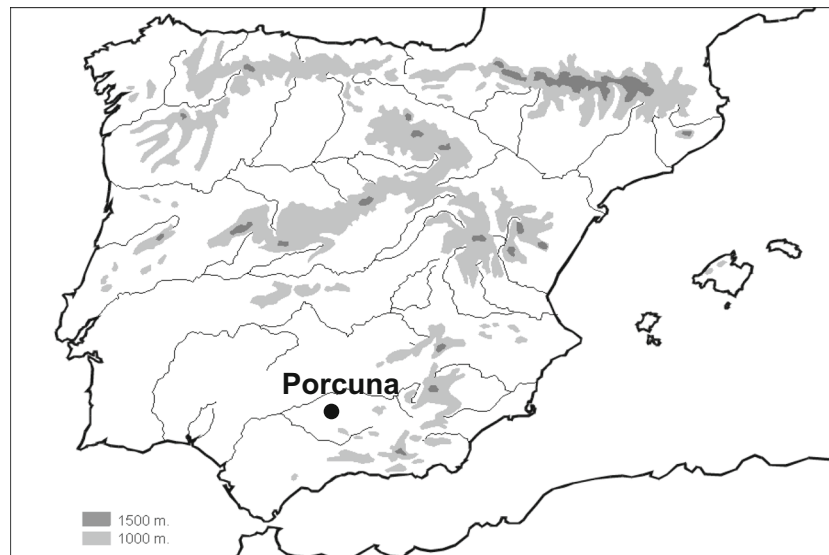


Fig. 1 The location of Porcuna on Iberian Peninsula
