The majority of our journals saw a rise in ISI impact factor against the previous year. *Pediatric Drugs* increased 15 % to 1.975, its highest point since the journal was launched, and we hope to build upon these gains, once more, in 2016.

Over 50 further titles are currently in development with leading academics, internationally, and we continue to add more to the list. Our thanks, again, to all who have submitted these valuable proposals to date.

Their skill and dedication are critical to the continued publication of the journal.
