***Kazankiella* nom. nov.—A New Replacement Name  
for a Permian Gastropod Genus**

In a recent paper (Mazaev, 2015) I established a new Middle Permian gastropod genus *Kazanella* from the Kazanian Stage of the Volga–Urals Region. This name was preoccupied by a Permian grylloblattodean (Insecta) (Martynov, 1930). In accordance with ICZN Article 60.3 (*The International ...*, 1999; *Mezhdunarodnyi ...*, 2000), the preoccupied name is hereby replaced by a new replacement name *Kazankiella* Mazaev, nom. nov. (type species *Turbonilla volgensis* Golowkinsky, 1868). The genus is named after the Kazanka River.
