The Heidelberg University Library is attempting to establish a comprehensive inventory of the complete correspondence of Wilhelm von Humboldt through its Wilhelm von Humboldt Letter Archive. Its goal is to publish a catalogue of all letters by and to Wilhelm von Humboldt. The material would include photostats of all the available letters and would thus form a new basis for Humboldt scholarship and for a possible critical edition of the correspondence, such as was originally planned as part of the Gesammelte Schriften of von Humboldt's works sponsored by the Prussian Academy of Sciences but which never was published.
