

## Analysis of S-RNase alleles of almond (*Prunus dulcis*): characterization of new sequences, resolution of synonyms and evidence of intragenic recombination

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Due to an unfortunate editorial typesetting error, one sentence under the heading Introduction was published incorrectly. The correct sentence is given here:

Sequences, or partial sequences, of the alleles  $S_1$ – $S_{10}$  (=‘ $S_{25}$ ’) and  $S_{23}$  as well as ‘putative  $S_{10}$ ’ (= $S_{24}$ ) have been published (Ushijima et al. 1998; Tamura et al. 2000; Channuntapipat et al. 2001, 2002; Ma and Oliveira 2001; López et al. 2004).

Also, another sentence under the heading Discussion was published incorrectly. The correct sentence is given here:

In addition, sequence comparisons confirmed the existence of four sets of synonymous alleles as already proposed by Ortega et al. (2005):  $S_1$ ,  $S_{16}$ , and  $S_{17}$ ;  $S_4$  and  $S_{20}$ ;  $S_5$  and  $S_{15}$ ; and  $S_{13}$  and  $S_{19}$ . In the case of  $S_1$  and  $S_{16}$ , the corresponding S-RNases appeared to have quite distinct isoelectric points, and also in the case of  $S_{13}$  and  $S_{19}$  (Bošković et al. 2003).
