ORGANIZATION

In 1967 the Police, Army, Navy and Air Force were integrated in to the Indonesian Armed Forces. The Police (Tentera Nasional Indonesia – Polisi, TNI-PO) is a paramilitary force which reports to the Ministry of Defence and Security and has a personnel strength of 110,000 in 11 territorial units and the Jakarta metropolitan area unit. It comprises five main directorates: Administration; Equipment and Buildings; Finance; Operations; and Research.

The Sea and Harbour Police is in charge of harbour patrol and customs duties. The 12,000-man Police Mobile Brigade is an airborne unit which operates its own aircraft and specializes in anti-terrorist duties. There is a Mobile Brigade School at Porong (East Java), and a Police Training School at Sukubumi (West Java).

The main internal security organ is the Command for the Restoration of Security and Order, usually known by the acronym Kopkamtib. It was created in 1965 under the authority of the Department of Defence and Security to oppose communist subversion. It is sometimes confused with Military Intelligence (Bakin), which has been under the same Commanding Officer for some time.
