Estuarine and Coastal Marine Science. Vol. 1/1 Jan. 1973. Academic Press London & New York £ 12.10 per volume (U.K. £ 10.60)

This new journal, published by Academic Press in association with the newly founded Estuarine and Brackish Water Sciences Association (Hon. Secr. DR R. S. K. BARNES, Cambridge U.K., Hon. Treasurer DR C. LITTLE, Bristol U.K.) is devoted to biological, geological, meteorological physical and chemical matters concerning coastal and brackish waters. It will appear quarterly and is edited by N. C. FLEMMING of Godalming U.K., B. H. KETCHUM of Woods Hole, U.S.A. and E. NAYLOR of Port Erin, U.K. The latter editor represents the E.B.S.A.

The first number – 111 pages – contains 9 articles and 2 notes, all from U.S.A. and U.K. These papers cover a.o. the subjects of physical oceanography, statistical treatment and diversity of fish populations, phytoplankton blooms and their relationship with increase of temperature and the action of petroleum hydrocarbons on sediments and benthic fauna. The editors feel that the increasing industrial, social and political pressures on the use of estuarine and coastal waters necessitate the creation of a special medium where data can be brought together. Their names warrant the highest academic standard of the papers to be published.

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
