

CORRIGENDUM

Asa Kasher and Ruth Manor, 'A Note on the Breadth and Depth of Terms',
Theory and Decision 11 (1979), 71–79.

The suggested formulation of the Law of Inverse Variation contained a typographical error, and should read:

- (8) For any terms x and y of the same syntactic category and relevant to each other, i.e. $x \rightarrow y$ or $y \rightarrow x$, $\text{Br}(x) \not\subseteq \text{Br}(y)$ iff $\text{Dp}(y) \not\subseteq \text{Dp}(x)$.

That the formulation should be formulated in terms of " $\not\subseteq$ " rather than " \subseteq " is clear from the preceding discussion of (6) and (7).

This obviates the apparent counter-example mentioned by David Makinson (*Mathematical Reviews*, 80m:03015).
