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Page 439, Figure 6 and Page 440, Table 1, Our recent direct substitution experiments of three anticodon bases on $tRNA^{His}$ to other nucleotides resulted in no change of the histidinyl activity. The difference between the time sequence curves of VH (G_1-C_{73}) and V (G_1-C_{73}) in Fig. 6 was caused by an accidental insertion of C instead of G at the 22^{nd} position of V (G_1-C_{73}) during gene synthesis. Consequently, the white circle in the AC column for Histidine in Table 1 should be replaced by a black circle.
