The terms provide a structured integration with the hospital work, including operating theatres, out-patients, wards, visits to the endoscopy suite, anorectal physiology, stoma care, pathology and radiology. Active participation is encouraged and overseen by tutors. Regular seminars are held to cover most aspects of coloproctology.

Ten postgraduates are allowed on each term. These are of 8 weeks' duration and designed for surgeons in training.
