## Addendum

Since this paper was accepted for publication we have seen a further 7 cases. All except one (a female) have been British breed animals and of these, 3 have been males. The first male animal was reported by Ogden, Palmer, and Blakemore in 1974. The condition has also been seen in Canada (L. Tryphonas, personal communication). All affected animals have been pedigree charolais.
