IN MEMORY OF V. A. MIKHALEV

Vladimir Alekseevich Mikhalev, one of the leading scientists of the S. Ordzhonikidze All-Union Institute of Pharmaceutical Chemistry, and Candidate of Chemical Sciences, died recently.

In 1938 Vladimir Alekseevich was graduated from the Chemistry Department of Moscow University. V. A. Mikhalev devoted his whole life to the development of new pharmaceutical materials and improvements in their production.

Vladimir Alekseevich was one of the pioneers of the industrial scale manufacture of highly effective synthetic antibiotics. In recent years he attempted to develop pharmaceuticals for the treatment of malignant tumors. In spite of his serious illness, Vladimir Alekseevich remained active right to the end and continued his work on the development and production of new pharmaceutical materials.

Vladimir Alekseevich was a member of the Editorial board of Khim-iko-Farmatsevticheskii Zhurnal and contributed greatly to the work of the board; he was continuously striving to improve the quality of our journal.

Vladimir Alekseevich will always be well remembered by all his colleagues and co-workers.
