On June 26, 1980, Dr. Ada S. Hill died after a brief illness. For the past decade, she has been a research associate at the New York State Agricultural Experiment Station, Geneva, New York, with Dr. Wendell L. Roelofs in pheromone research. In that time, she has identified the pheromone blend of over 25 lepidopterous species. She has developed a number of international cooperative projects and was a devoted friend to scientists around the world, who are saddened by her untimely death.
