Kansas City was the site, from October 22 to 25, 1983, of the 15th National Meeting of the American Association for the Advancement of Slavic Studies. The philosophy panels at this meeting were chaired by Professors Richard T. DeGeorge (University of Kansas, Lawrence) and William Gavin (University of Southern Maine, Portland).

The panel on 'Soviet Philosophy Through the Eyes of V. P. Tugarinov', introduced in this issue by Professor DeGeorge's comments, consists of the papers by James J. O'Rourke (St. Anselm's College, Manchester) and T. J. Blakeley (Boston College); while Professor Gavin has provided an introduction to the other session, 'Marxism and Pragmatism', with papers by Tom Rockmore (Fordham University) and John Ryder (SUNY-Cortland).
