

### Pfizer Travel Fellowships for 1972

The generosity of our supporting member, Pfizer Pharmaceuticals, makes it possible to announce for 1972 the availability — through the European Association for the Study of Diabetes — of two or more travel fellowship awards, not to exceed the total amount of \$ 8000 in any one year. The following outlines the rules governing the award of these fellowships: (1) The purpose of these fellowships is that of making it possible for two or more investigators, usually residing in Europe or members of the European Association for the Study of Diabetes, to travel to the United States for periods of one to six months in order to acquire information or methodology which will improve their ability to carry out diabetes-related research. — (2) Applications for the 1972 awards should be made to the Executive Committee of the European Association for the Study of Diabetes, and received by the Executive Director at the following address:

Such applications will consist of a curriculum vitae, with list of publications, a description of the purpose of the planned visit to the United States (not to exceed 1000 words), a brief statement of the person(s) responsible for the institution or institutions to be visited. The application should also mention the names of two persons familiar with the applicants' qualifications and programme. It should mention the intended duration of each visit and the subsidy requested, the latter not to exceed \$ 4000 for any one applicant. — (3) Applications for the 1972 awards should be received by the *Executive Director prior to Sept. 1st, 1972*. — (4) For the selection of awardees, first consideration will be given to the scientific interest of the project and the scientific qualifications and promise of the candidates. Secondly, and particularly for more senior applicants, participation of the institution of origin in contributing toward the total expenses involved will be considered evidence of special interest in the candidate.
