VII. Karlsburg Symposium on Problems of Diabetes, September 29 to October 1, 1971

Organized by the "Sektion Diabetes in der Gesellschaft für Endokrinologie und Stoffwechselkrankheiten der DDR" and the "Zentralinstitut für Diabetes Gerhardt Katsch", Karlsburg, Kreis Greifswald/German Democratic Republic, an international meeting on "Insulin-Biosynthesis and Secretion" took place.
