

Erratum

While attempting to enlarge our original, preliminary small sample of recordings in autistic children (**Evidence from Auditory Nerve and Brainstem Evoked Responses for an Organic Brain Lesion in Children with Autistic Traits**, *Journal of Autism and Childhood Schizophrenia*, 1978, Volume 8, Number 1, pages 13-20), we found that at the time that the study was conducted there was a malfunction with our display oscilloscope which occasionally gave rise to inaccurate latency values. When appropriate corrections are made, we find that the average Brainstem Transmission Time (BTT) value of the autistic group is still prolonged but the difference in BTT between the autistic and control groups is no longer significant.
