



during execution. This part of the code was modularized and easily adapted for specific computers. In its present form, the code can take advantage of solid state memory devices and multiple processors if available but does not require them to operate.

(c) The Simulation

The model will be used to simulate the 3-dimensional flow in and around a submarine canyon incised into the continental shelf and slope. This topic has been studied very little. Only recently have detailed field studies been performed in which current measurements were made at several depths in the canyon; usually they have focused on near bottom measurements for studying turbidity current. Earlier runs

on the NEC SX2 indicate the higher resolution is required in the canyon. The newer code is structured for variable grid spacing so that additional grid points can be concentrated in the submarine canyon while allowing relatively sparse points over the uniform shelf region.

Two figures show distributions of vertical velocity for runs 30 at day 30. The model consists of three levels for the shelf and three for the canyon with the first level contacting the atmosphere and the sixth one the bottomt Fig. 1 and Fig. 2 represent the values at level 2 and level 6, respectively. Arrows indicate direction of geostrophic flows. Both figures indicate steady strong upwelling near the head. Sharp peaks at the entrance may be transitory. (Matt Howard.)
