In the paper of Massaro A.R. "Notes on the therapy of multiple sclerosis (MS)" (Suppl. 14: 137-143, 1992) in the Table I a arrow is absent.

TABLE I. Possible combinations of MRI features with data on MBP levels in the CSF. From these combinations, significant therapeutic implications can be obtained.

Focal lesion of the BBB (myelin is only injured, but not dead nor destroyed)	→	PRESENCE OF CLINICAL SIGNS AND SYMPTOMS (secondary to functional "out of order")	NO INCREASE OF CSF MBP EV- IDENCE OF LESION AT MRI
	→	ABSENCE OF CLINICAL SIGNS AND SYMPTOMS (there is only evidence at MRI, but myelin function is preserved)	
Demyelination	→	PRESENCE OF CLINICAL SYMP- TOMS AND SIGNS (unless "silent areas" are dam- aged)	INCREASE OF CSF MBP EVID- ENCE OF LESION AT MRI
