Under a grant from the Advanced Science Seminar Program of the National Science Foundation, The rand Corporation has begun the third year of an already internationally known program to familiarize young scholars with the use of computer techniques in linguistic studies. Among four post-graduate students who will participate in the program during the next academic year is Heddy Jason, who has a B.A. from Hebrew University in Jerusalem and an M.A. from Indiana University, where she has completed work for a doctorate in folklore. She will be working on a formal analysis of the narrative structure of folk tales and epic songs.
