

Klassifikation, „Working Formulation“, REAL-Klassifikation) sind in nur sehr eingeschränktem Maße auf gastrointestinale Lymphome (u. a. extranodale Lymphome) anwendbar. Eine definitive (international anerkannte) Klassifikation existiert derzeit nicht und ist auch in nächster Zeit nicht zu erwarten. Zusammen mit einer exakten Stadieneinteilung stellt die Klassifikation die Grundlage für eine adäquate patientenspezifisch angepaßte Therapie dar.
