

Errata

In Robert L. Clark's recent article "Media, Mental Imagery, and Learning" (ECTJ, Vol. 26, No. 4), instructions for drawing Design Number 9 (Figure 2, p. 363) were printed incorrectly. Those instructions should read:

Draw a square. Inside the square draw a circle that touches the edges of the square. From the upper left-hand corner of the square draw a line to the circle—dividing that area in half. Inside the circle draw another circle, centered so as to

form a letter "O." Now, inside the smaller circle draw another circle making a smaller letter "O." Shade in the area between the smallest circle and the next larger circle. Inside the smallest circle make a cross, with one line from top to bottom and one line from side to side.

As Dr. Clark pointed out, it would be impossible to draw the design from the instructions as printed. The editors regret the error.
