was some atonic hæmorrhage following this which was easily controlled by intravenous

The mother's convalescence was normal. She received 24 grammes of sulphathiazole prophylactically in 4-hourly doses of 1 gram. The baby has done very well.

Summary.

An attempt is made to define a constriction ring. A brief review of the literature is given. A case is described.
