

## IRISH MEDICAL OBITUARY, 1941.

### AHERN, MICHAEL DAVID.

Elder son of the late T. Ahern of Glanmire, Cork. Born September 6, 1876. Educated at Clongowes Wood College and Queen's College, Cork. L.R.C.P. & S. Edinb., L.R.F.P.S., Glasgow, 1902. Entered R.A.M.C., 1904. Lt.-Col., 1926; retired, 1931. O.B.E. Died in Dublin May 10th, 1941.

### ALLISON, ROBERT.

Eldest son of the Rev. James Allison. Born in Monaghan in 1877. Educated in Belfast and the R.C.S.I. L.R.C.P. & S.I., 1902. In practice for the past thirty-five years in Coleraine, where he died April 24th, 1941.

### BEGLEY, JOHN FRANCIS.

Educated in the Catholic University School, Dublin. M.B., B.Ch., B.A.O., R.U.I., 1900. House Surgeon, Jervis Street Hospital. In practice in London, and there killed in an air raid in March, 1941.

### CRAWFORD, JOHN JONES.

Youngest son of John Crawford, J.P., Drumshambo. Educated in Trinity College. B.A., 1895; M.B., B.Ch., B.A.O., 1897; M.D., 1901. For a time ship's surgeon, and then R.M.O. of the Victoria Hospital, Burnley, and the Union Infirmary, Leeds. Died at Beverley, Yorks, June 13th, 1941.

### CULLEN, JOSEPH JAMES.

Born at Maynooth in 1868. Educated at Castleknock College and University College, Dublin. L.R.C.P. & S.I., 1891; D.P.H., 1913. M.O.H. North Dublin Union, and M.O. Castleknock Dispensary. Died May 28th, 1941.

### DALY, THOMAS.

Son of James M. Daly, Co. Clare. Educated at Blackrock College and University College, Dublin. M.B., B.Ch., B.A.O., N.U.I., 1921. M.O. Kiltrush Dispensary District. Died in Dublin, April, 1941.

### DELANY, MICHAEL.

Educated at St. Peter's College, Wexford, and the Catholic University School. L.R.C.P. & S.I., 1895. M.O. Clonroche Dispensary District, Ennis-corthy. Died April 8th, 1941.

### ELLISON, FRANCIS CHARLES.

Educated at Trinity College, Dublin. B.A., 1888; M.B., B.Ch., B.A.O. and M.D., 1893. During the Great War served in R.A.M.C. Late Superintendent Co. Mayo Mental Hospital. Died at Greystones, May 11th, 1941.

### EYRE, JOHN JOSEPH.

Eldest son of Edmund Eyre of Shanagolden, Limerick. Educated at the Ledwich School, Dublin, and University College, London. L.R.C.S.I., 1873; L.K.Q.C.P.I., 1875; Member, 1883. Formerly Physician at Salsomaggiore. Died February 26th, 1941.

### FERGUS, SAMUEL.

Born September 16th, 1853. Educated at Queen's College, Belfast. M.D., 1875; M.Ch., & L.M., 1876 (Q.U.I.). For a time in practice in Moy, and afterwards in Leeds. Died March 2nd, 1941.

### GORE-GRIMES, JOHN PATRICK.

Younger son of C. M. Gore-Grimes, born in Dublin, 1916. Educated at St. Gerrard's School, Bray and Trinity College. B.A., M.B., B.Ch., B.A.O., 1939. Killed while on duty in Coventry and Warwick Hospital in an air raid, April 9th, 1941.

## GRAHAM, WILLIAM MEDLYCOTT.

Son of Robert James Graham, born in Dublin, April 11th, 1862. Educated at Rathmines School and Trinity College. B.A., 1892; M.B., B.Ch., B.A.O., 1893. Formerly Chief M.O. Sierra Leone Government Railway. M.O. West African Medical Service, 1899. Director, Med. Research Institute, Lagos, 1908. Died in Dublin, March 25th, 1941.

## GROSVENOR, ALFRED AUGUSTUS.

L.S.A.Lond., 1890; M.R.C.S.Eng., 1891; M.A.Cantab., B.A. and M.B., 1896; M.D., 1897 Dub. Divisional Police Surgeon and M.O., L.N.E. Railway, Hitchin, Herts. Died at Stevenage, Herts, March 25th, 1941.

## HALL, ROBERT.

Son of Hugh Hall, born at Clonduff, Co. Down, 1861. Educated at Queen's College, Belfast. L.R.C.P. & S. Edinb., 1880. Physician to Belfast Infirmary, 1881. Med. Superintendent Abbey Sanatorium, Belfast, 1904-1914; M.O. Belfast Municipal Sanatorium, 1914-1941. Died in Belfast, March 29th, 1941.

## HARTIGAN, JOHN.

Eldest son of the late Dr. J. T. Hartigan of Croom. Born at Croom, June 16th, 1875. Educated at University College, Dublin. Late Assistant Master National Maternity Hospital, Dublin, and Med. Superintendent Hamadryad Seamen's Hospital. Capt., R.A.M.C., Glamorgan Volunteers. Examiner in Midwifery, Apothecary's Hall, Dublin. Died at Weybridge, May 4th, 1941.

## HARTIGAN, THOMAS.

Son of the late J. T. Hartigan of Limerick. Educated in Dublin and Newcastle-on-Tyne. M.B., B.S., 1893; M.D., Durham, 1907. For many years in practice in London. Died April 2nd, 1941.

## HURST, HENRY.

Born in Bantry, Co. Cork, February 6th, 1895. Educated at the Royal College of Surgeons. L.R.C.P. & S.I., 1917. Surgeon Commander R.N. Killed in H.M.S. Hood, May 24th, 1941.

## IRWIN, EDWARD HENRY.

Son of James Irwin of Armagh. Born in Armagh on March 19th, 1874. Educated at Royal School, Armagh, and University of Edinburgh. M.B., C.M., 1897; M.D., 1908 Edinb.; F.R.C.S.Ed., 1904. In practice at Castleblayney from 1898 till his death on April 3rd, 1941.

## KAVANAGH, EDWARD JAMES.

M.B., B.Ch., B.A.O., R.U.I., 1906; Lt.-Col. R.A.M.C., retired; M.C., D.S.O. Died April 19th, 1941.

## KELLY, LUKE PATRICK.

Second son of J. Kelly of Galway. M.B., B.Ch., B.A.O., N.U.I., 1940. Died in Galway, May, 1941.

## KELSALL, CHARLES.

Born August 19th, 1884. Educated in the Royal College of Surgeons. L.R.C.P. & S.I., 1910. Service in West African Medical Staff. Died in the Isle of Man, March 26th, 1941.

## KENNEDY, ANTHONY BERNARD.

Son of P. J. Kennedy of Enfield, Co. Meath. Educated in the Royal College of Surgeons. L.R.C.P. & S.I., 1924. Late House Physician London Hospital for Diseases of the Heart; Clinical Assistant Maudsley Hospital for Nervous Diseases. Died in London, April 19th, 1941.

## KENNEDY, JOHN MURRAY PRIOR.

Educated at the Royal College of Surgeons. L.R.C.S.I., 1883; L.K.Q.C.P.I., 1883. Formerly Resident Surgeon, Richmond Hospital, Dublin. Rugby International, 1882. Surgeon, Tullamore Prison. Died at Tullamore, April 21st, 1941, aged 82.

**LAIRD, CHARLES WILLIAM.**

Born in Belfast, 1879. Educated in Trinity College. B.A., 1903; M.B., B.Ch., B.A.O., 1908; M.D., 1911; D.P.H. Liverpool, 1912. Consulting Tuberculosis Officer Lancs. Co. Council and Visiting Physician, Rufford Pulmonary Hospital. Late M.O.H. Bootle. Died April 19th, 1941.

**MCCANN, ARTHUR EDMUND**

Youngest son of John Henry McCann of Drogheda. Educated at the Royal College of Surgeons. L.R.C.P. & S.I., 1893. Late House Surgeon, Jervis Street Hospital, and M.O. Mountmellick Dispensary. Died in Dublin, June 10th, 1941.

**MCCARTHY, DANIEL.**

Born August 15th, 1896. Educated University College, Cork. M.B., B.Ch., B.A.O. N.U.I., 1921. Late House Surgeon, Rotherham Hospital, and afterwards in practice in Tralee. Died in Tralee, January 28th, 1941.

**MCCLOGHRY, CHARLES EDWARD.**

Son of J. Palmer McCloghry, born in Sligo. Educated at Queen's University, Belfast. M.B., B.Ch., B.A.O., 1936. Lt., R.A.M.C., April, 1937; Capt., 1938. Service in Palestine. Died in Natal, March 18th, 1941.

**MCCLOSKEY, GERRARD PATRICK.**

Educated in Queen's University, Belfast. M.B., B.Ch., B.A.O., 1924; D.P.H., 1927, Belfast. M.O.H. Waterlooville Urban District Council, Hants. Killed in air raid while on visit to Belfast, April 17th, 1941.

**MARKS, HUGH.**

Son of Hugh Marks, born at Randalstown, Co. Antrim, 1907. Educated at Portora and Queen's University, Belfast. L.R.C.P. & S.I., 1939. For a time Resident Surgeon Kidderminster Hospital, and then joined the Royal Navy. Killed sixteen days after he joined his first ship, March, 1941.

**MINCHIN, WILLIAM CHARLES.**

Educated in Trinity College. B.A., 1889; M.B., B.Ch., B.A.O., 1890; M.D., 1898. For a time M.O. Kells Dispensary and Fever Hospital. Died at Hastings, March 22nd, 1941, aged 78.

**MOORE, ROBERT.**

Son of J. Gibson Moore of Merrion, Co. Dublin. Educated at Trinity College. B.A., 1893; M.B., B.Ch., B.A.O., & M.D., 1895. In practice in Essex. Died March 3rd, 1941.

**NORRIS, HERBERT MURRAY.**

Educated at Anderson College and University of Glasgow. L.K.Q.C.P.I., 1886. In practice in London. Died at Sidmouth, May 11th, 1941.

**OAKSHOTT, JAMES ALBERT.**

Born, 1859. Educated at Queen's College, Cork. M.D., 1880; M.Ch. & L.M., R.U.I., 1881. Formerly Assistant M.O. District Asylum, Cork, and later M.O. District Asylum, Waterford. Died March 26th, 1941.

**O'FLAHERTY, ROMAULD AUSTIN.**

Son of Thomas Austin O'Flaherty, born in Kilkenny, 1870. Educated Queen's College, Cork. L.S.A. Lond., 1897; L.R.C.P. Lond.,; M.R.C.S. Eng., 1901. R.A.M.C. Service in Africa, India, and Mesopotamia. Lt.-Col. Died at Westward Ho., Devon, April 8th, 1941.

**O'KELLY, EDWARD JOSEPH.**

Son of Dr. T. O'Kelly of Maynooth. Educated in University College, Dublin. L.A.H. Dub., 1926. In practice in London. Killed in air raid April, 1941.

**ORR, JOHN JAMES.**

Son of James Orr. Educated at Queen's College, Cork. M.D., M.Ch., 1887; R.U.I., L.M.R.C.P.I., 1888. Late House Surgeon Chelsea, Brompton and Belgrave Dispensary and afterwards for many years in Kinsale. Died in Kinsale, May 20th, 1941.

**PIERCE, MICHAEL JOSEPH.**

L.R.C.P. & S.I., 1908. Formerly House Physician St. Vincent's Hospital. In practice in Liverpool. Died February 19th, 1941.

**POE, JOHN.**

Born in Kilkenny, 1873. Educated in Trinity College. B.A., 1895; M.B., B.Ch., B.A.O., 1896; Lt. R.A.M.C., 1897; Col. A.M.S., 1916; D.S.O., 1915; C.M.G., 1919. Died May 13th, 1941.

**QUINLAN, JOHN FINBARR.**

M.B., B.Ch., B.A.O., 1928. M.O. Loughrea, Co. Galway. Died May 19th, 1941.

**ROCHE, REDMOND.**

Son of John Redmond Roche. Educated at Clongowes. B.A. R.U.I., L.R.C.P. Lond., M.R.C.S. Eng., 1894. Was Resident Surgeon Richmond Hospital, Demonstrator in Anatomy R.C.S.I.; Ship's Surgeon, Dominion Line; Surgeon Major 1st Cadet Batt., King's R. Rifles. In practice in Westminster, where he died May 6th, 1941, aged 74.

**SEALE, RICHARD.**

Born December 20th, 1892. Educated in Trinity College. B.A., 1921. M.B., B.Ch., B.A.O., 1922; M.A. & M.D., 1925; D.P.H., 1923 Dub. Formerly Resident, Royal City of Dublin Hospital and New End Hospital, Hampstead. Hon. M.O. Harrow Hospital. Died January 25th, 1941.

**SHEEHAN, HONORA TERESA.**

Honora Teresa Carroll was born at Hospital, Co. Limerick, October 24th, 1899, and educated at Queen's College, Cork. M.B., B.Ch., B.A.O., N.U.I., 1924. In practice in Longford and then in London where she married, September, 1929, Dr. Timothy Sheehan. Afterwards she practised in partnership with her husband in London, and died there, May 14th, 1941.

**SMYLY, SIR WILLIAM JOSIAH.**

Son of Josiah Smyly, F.R.C.S.I. Born in Dublin, November 14th, 1850. Educated in Trinity College. B.A., M.B., 1873; M.D., 1875; L.K.Q.C.P.I., 1872; Member, 1882; Fellow, 1884. L.R.C.S.I., 1872; Fellow, 1877. Master of the Rotunda Hospital, 1889-1896. President, R.C.P.I., 1904-1906. Died March 19th, 1941.

**WHITEACRE, ROBERT DERMOT.**

Son of George P. Whiteacre of Foxrock, Co. Dublin. Educated in Trinity College. B.A., 1925; M.B., B.Ch., B.A.O., 1927. Died at Southsea, May 6th, 1941.
