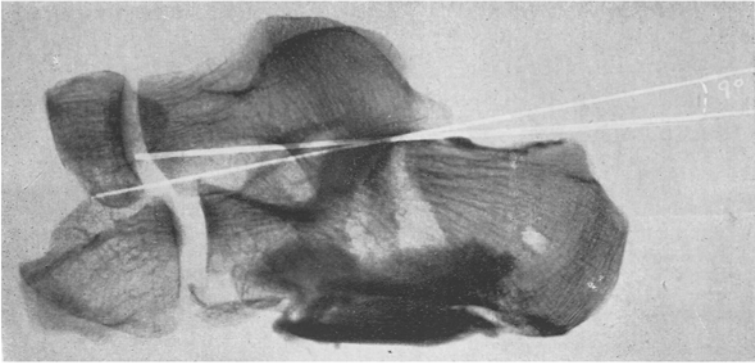


FIG. 1. Os calcis after fracture showing salient angle reduced to 9°

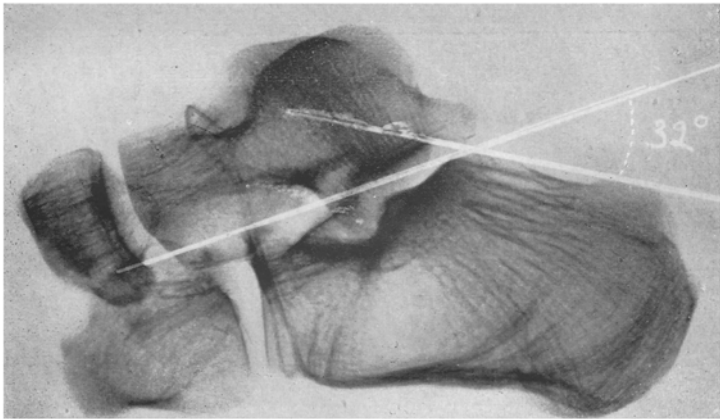


FIG. 2. Sound heel for comparison.

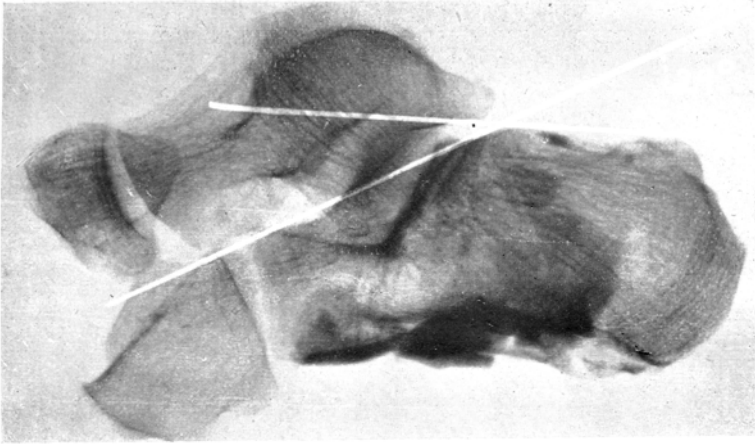


FIG. 3. Fractured heel after reduction showing salient angle restored to 29° .

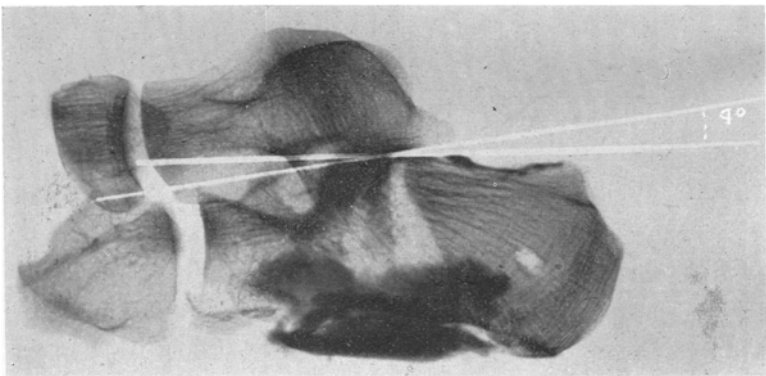


FIG. 4. Os calcis three years later showing salient angle back to 9° .

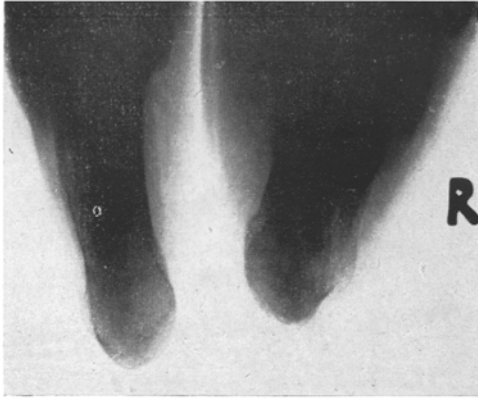


FIG. 5. Axial view of right heel following fracture with left for comparison.

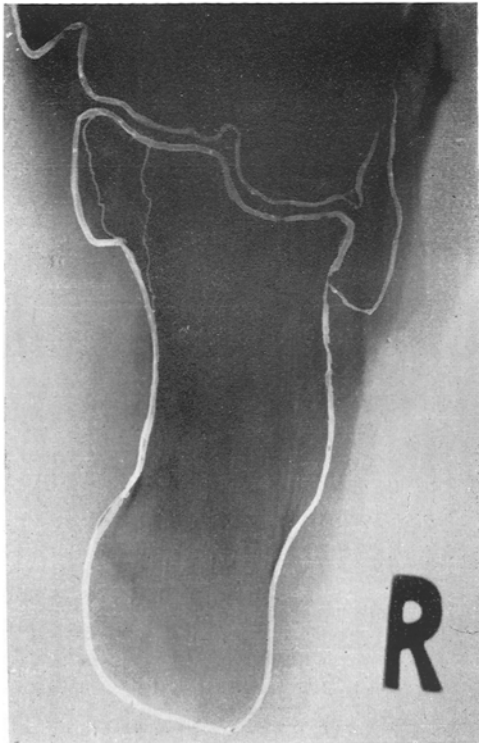


FIG. 8. Axial view showing sustentaculum tali and calcaneo-cuboid joint.

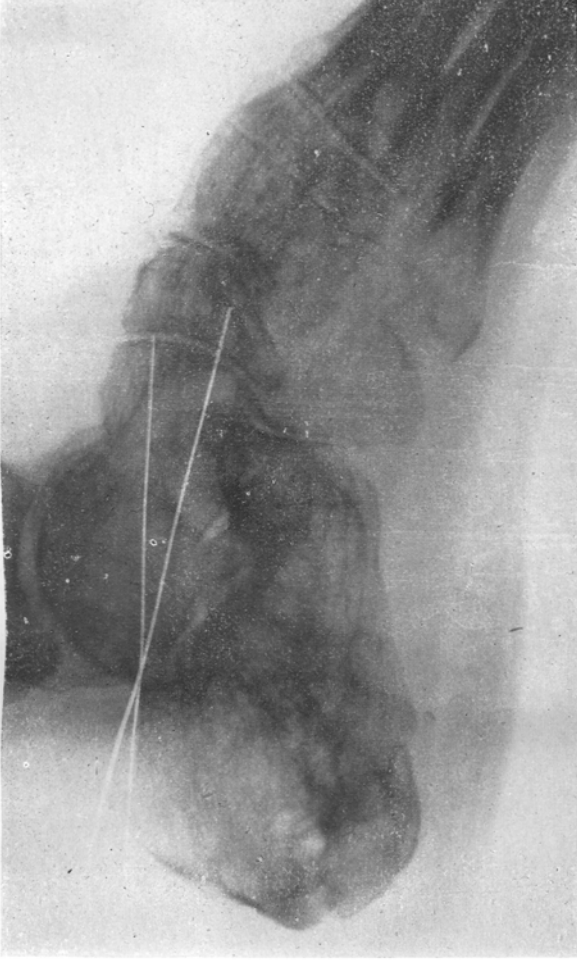


FIG. 9. Osteoporosis of bones of foot present three years after initial injury.

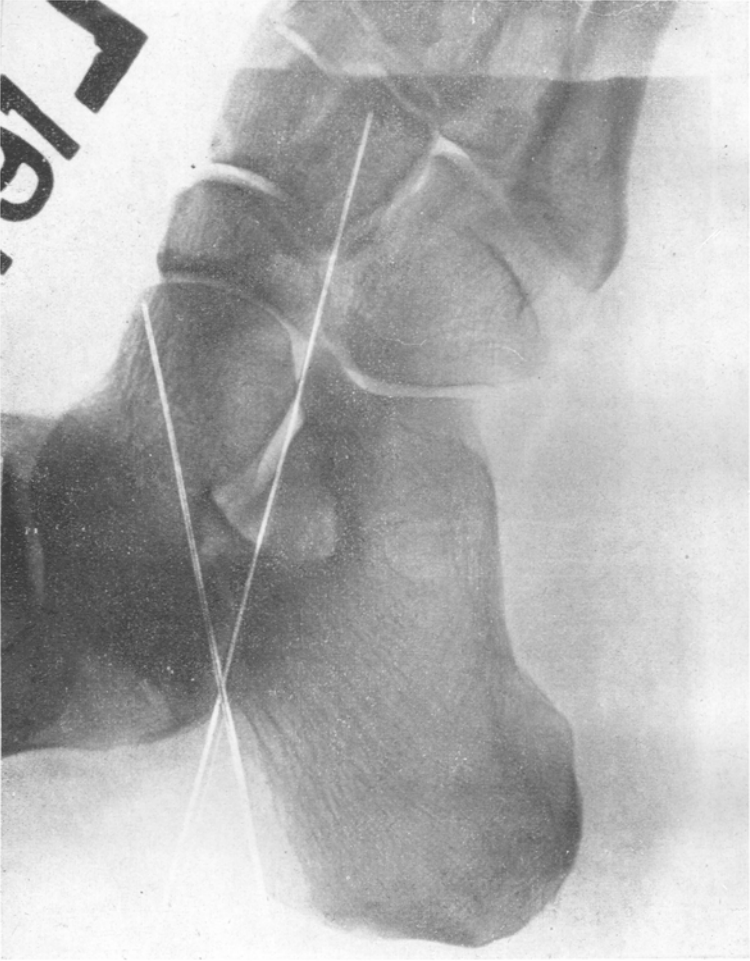


FIG. 10. Sound foot for comparison.
