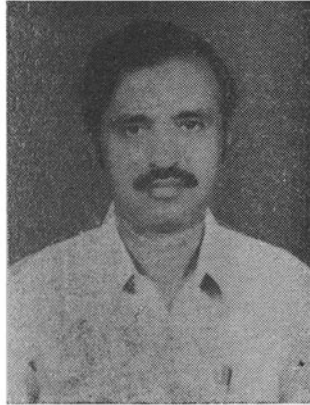

OBITUARY
