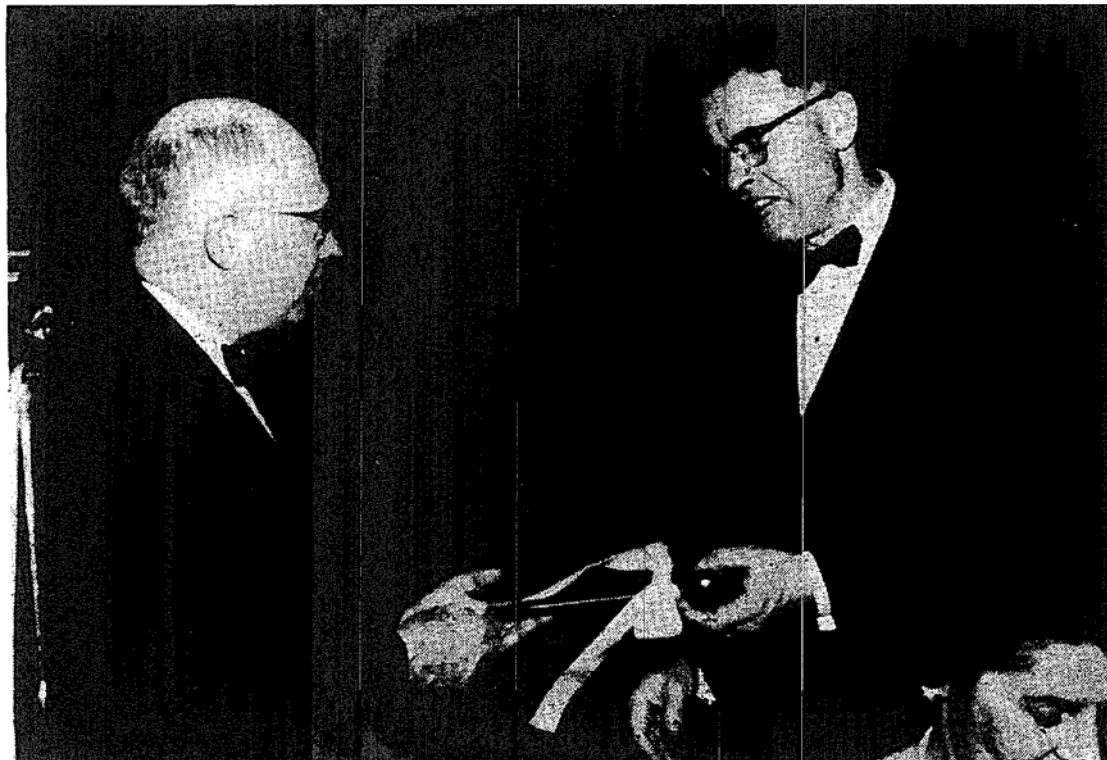
CANADIAN ANAESTHETISTS' SOCIETY ANNUAL MEETING

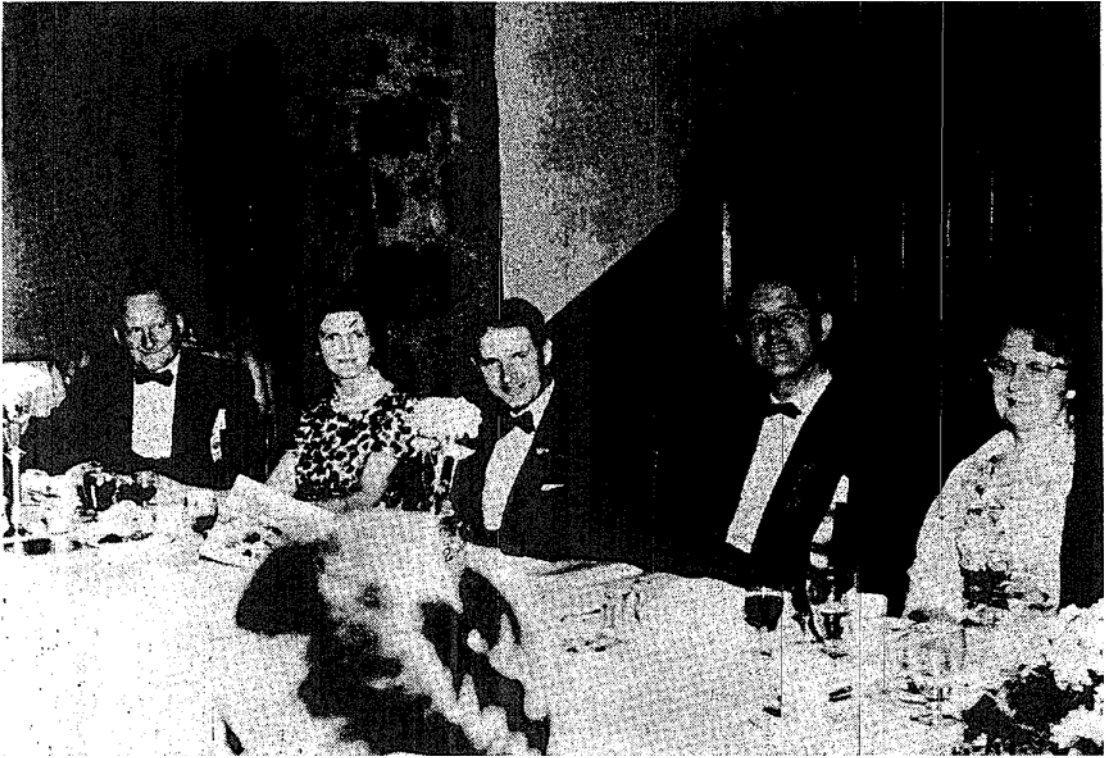

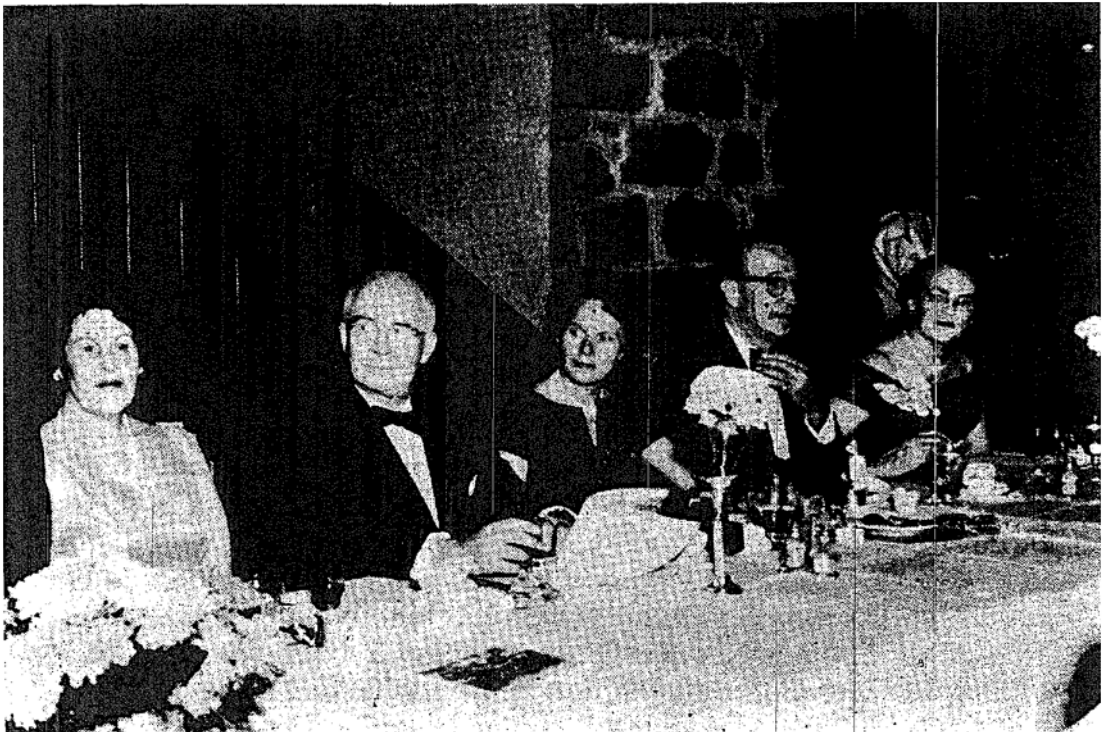
The Annual Meeting of 1964 will again be held at the Seignory Club from May 11 to 15.
