

ADDENDUM

THE PAPER "Was it Halothane? A Case Report," by Paul H. Lorhan, M.D. and Howard E. Keigh, M.D., which appeared in the issue of January 1966 (volume 13, page 68) failed to mention that halothane was the principal agent, along with a mixture of N₂O 2 litres and O₂ 2 litres, administered with a Foregger machine. The flow of halothane varied from 0.8 for induction to 1.5 per cent and 1.0 per cent for the last hour of the operation.
