NEUROANESTHESIA FELLOWSHIP

A Neuroanesthesia Fellowship at the University of Manitoba is available for September 1, 1992. The Fellow would become involved in both adult clinical and animal research projects with one or two days of clinical commitment per week for salary support. The clinical neuroanesthesia case load shared between two teaching hospitals numbers 1500 with a strong emphasis on neurovascular procedures and carotid endarterectomies. Currently there is active research into optimizing anesthetic management for carotid endarterectomy and supratentorial tumour surgery. Large and small animal research is done in a fully equipped laboratory with a strong interest in cerebral blood flow/metabolism studies during cardiopulmonary bypass, using radioactive microsphere techniques. A chronic canine model has been developed to study paraplegia following thoracic aortic cross-clamping. Applications are invited from candidates eligible for or who have obtained the Canadian Fellowship in Anaesthesia or American Board Certification and are eligible for a College of Physicians and Surgeons of Manitoba full licence.
