SCA/*McSPI* Fellowship

The SCA and *McSPI* announce a fellowship program to develop outstanding young investigators in the fields of cardiovascular and cerebrovascular clinical research. These groups recognize that formal research training in study design, epidemiology and biostatistics, and extensive clinical experience in cardiovascular anesthesia is necessary to become an excellent clinical researcher in cardiovascular anesthesia. Essential to this program is the design and execution of individual protocols that address substantive problems in perioperative cardiac and central nervous system morbidity.

The fellowship program is highly competitive and will select one anesthesiology resident or junior faculty from the USA or Canada nominated by an academic anesthesiology department.

Program Characteristics

- Duration:** 2 year program – commencing July 1, 1994
- Month 1 – 12/18:
 - intensive, formal courses in epidemiology, research study design and biostatistics at *McSPI*, UCSF
 - design of a focused research project
 - clinical anesthesia (0 – 20%)
- Month 12/18 – 24:
 - implement research project at sponsoring anesthesia department
 - clinical cardiac anesthesia (20 – 60%)
- Eligibility:** Board eligible/certified anesthesiology resident/faculty; citizen or permanent resident of the USA or Canada; member of the SCA
- Sponsorship:** \$50,000 per annum (salary and benefits); additional educational support
- Contributors:** \$25,000 – ICI Americas Inc (x 2 years)
\$25,000 – sponsoring Anesthesia Department (x 2 years)
