Appointment of Obstetrical Anaesthesia Professor for Academic Year July 1, 1997 – June 30, 1998



The University of Toronto, Department of Anaesthesia and the Department of Anaesthesia at Women's College Hospital are pleased to announce the appointment of Dr. Barbara Leighton as the Visiting Professor in Obstetrical Anaesthesia. Dr. Leighton will join the Centre for Research in Women's Health at Women's College Hospital, devoting 60% of her time to clinical research in obstetrical pain management and serving as an important resource person to researchers and clinicians at Women's College Hospital and other teaching hospitals within the University of Toronto system.
