It is with deep regret that we announce the passing of William Stephenson at the age of 87. A longtime member of the Board of Editors of *The Psychological Record*, William was the originator and proponent of the "Q" methodology for measuring attitudes. The method is widely used in psychology and several related disciplines. He earned doctorates in physics and psychology in his native Great Britain before coming to this country and the University of Missouri at Columbia. William's scholarship continued throughout his life and he was a regular contributor to this journal. His last article, "William James, Niels Bohr, and Complementarity: V - Phenomenology of Subjectivity," appeared in the Spring 1988 issue. *The Psychological Record* was honored to have him as a member of its editorial board and we shall miss his support and counsel.
