*Methods* A total of 475 migrant workers from four major districts in Shanghai were recruited through a survey design with a multistage cluster sampling. Male and female migrant workers were identified as mentally healthy or unhealthy using the brief symptom inventory. Socio-demographic characteristics and migration stress were explored as correlates of the mental health of the migrant workers.
