ILRS News

The Transportable Integrated Geodetic Observatory (TIGO) SLR system, located in Concepcion, Chile, is fully operational again after the devastating earthquake on February 27, 2010. The system has been continually tracking laser ranging targets since April 29 after repositioning the telescope and optical components within the laser container. The system is operated by the Bundesamt fuer Kartographie und Geodaesie (BKG) in cooperation with Chilean university partners.
