Dr. Sosa is Treasurer of the American Thyroid Association and serves on the Board of Directors/Executive Council of the ATA, International Thyroid Oncology Group, and Society for Surgical Oncology, as well as practice guidelines committees for the ATA and the NCCN. Dr. Sosa was born in Montreal and raised in upstate New York. She received her AB at Princeton, MA at Oxford, and MD at Johns Hopkins University, where she completed the Halsted surgery residency and a fellowship in surgical oncology. I have been honored to serve the ISS/SIC and the World Journal of Surgery for the past 13 years, and am looking forward to the new heights that Dr. Sosa will take the World Journal of Surgery.
