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Unfortunately, the original version of this article contained two mistakes.

The text passage “It should be mentioned here that in the case of apixaban, dose adjustment is not based on GFR. A lower dosage of apixaban should be used if serum creatinine is ≥ 1.5 mg/dl (133 μ mol/l) and either one of the following criteria is fulfilled: age ≥ 80 years or weight ≤ 60 kg.” is incorrect because GFR alone is a

dose reduction criterion for apixaban in patients with NVAf if it falls below 30 ml/min.

In addition the sentence “There are specific recommendations for dose reduction of dabigatran and apixaban in patients ≥ 80 years, but not for rivaroxaban and edoxaban” is incorrect. The correct sentence should be “There are specific recommendations for dose reduction of dabigatran and—only in NVAf—apixaban in patients ≥ 80 years, but not for rivaroxaban and edoxaban.”
