In order to encourage basic science research in the field of spinal disorders, the *European Spine Journal* is proud to announce the **GRAMMER *European Spine Journal* Award for Basic Science and Applied Research (20,000 Euro)**.

This is the highest amount of an award in spinal research, worldwide. Each paper submitted to the Journal dealing with basic science qualifies automatically for this award as soon as it has been published. The winning paper will be selected at the end of each academic year (for the next time in 2021/2022) and will be announced in one of the following issues.

The GRAMMER Award will also be presented at the next EUROSPINE meeting. At least one author of the winning paper must attend at his/her own expense the EUROSPINE 2022 meeting, which is being held in Milan (Italy) from October 19-21, to present the paper and receive the award.
