




Correction to: Intra-host diversity of hepatitis B virus during mother-to-child transmission: the X gene may play a key role in virus survival in children after transmission

1. In table 1, in column 2, the unit of age for the children (C) should be corrected to months and not years, as follows:
Age (years for mothers [M], months for children [C])
2. The sentence in the abstract: “Three groups were infected with HBV genotype C, and six groups were infected with HBV genotype B”, should be changed to “Three groups had an infection of HBV genotype C

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
