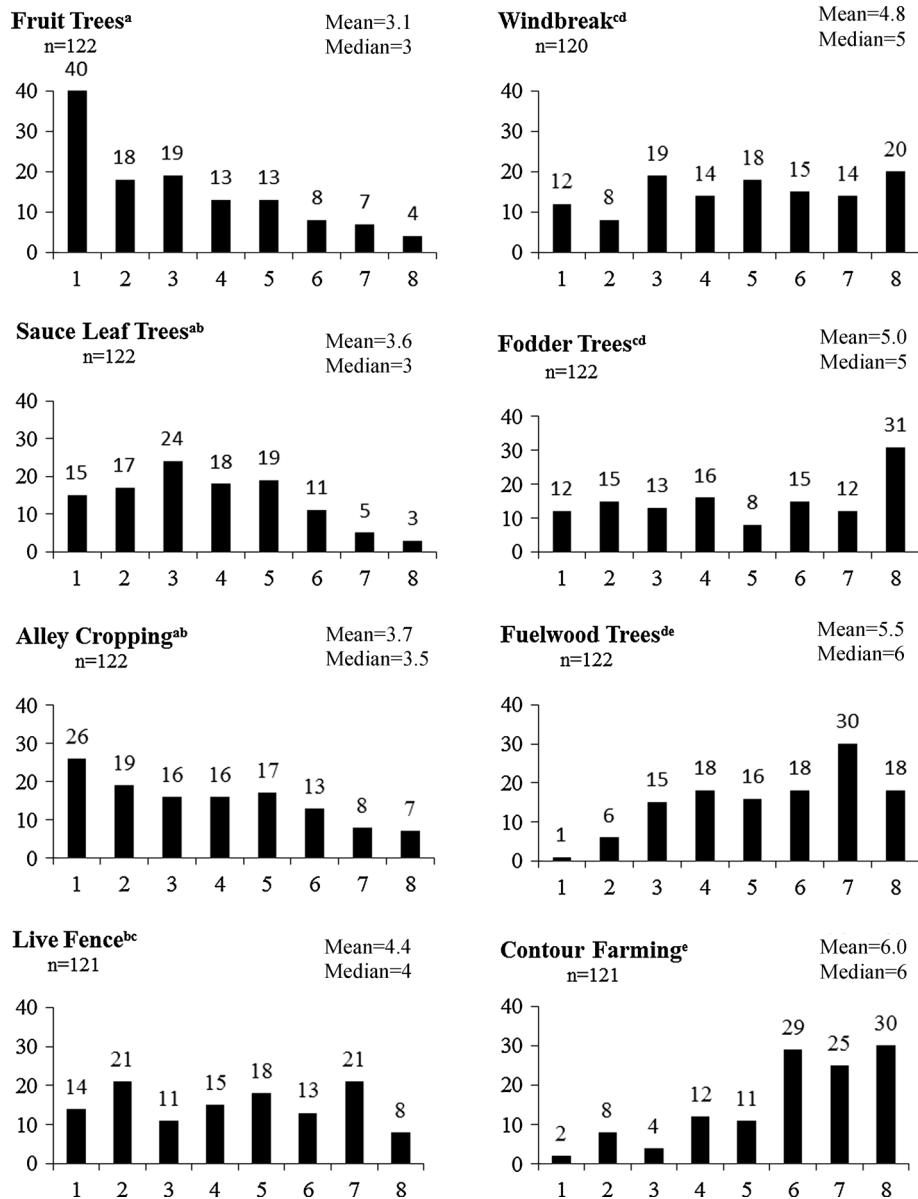


Fig. 3 Frequencies of rank scores for each agroforestry practice, with mean and median. Practices that do not share superscript letters are significantly different based on Kruskal–
