



Fig. 1 Path model for the association of depressive symptoms to antiretroviral medication adherence with the indirect association of medication self-efficacy modeled. Covariates were not included in

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The original version of this article unfortunately contained a mistake in Fig. 1. The figure was incorrectly presented with the results of an additional path model for forgotten antiretroviral therapy (ART) doses that was dropped from the primary analyses. The corrected Fig. 1 which is presented with this erratum contains four path models for each of the primary outcome variables: 95% adherence in the last month, self-reported detectable viral load, deliberate adjustments to ART regimen and skipped ART doses.
