For more than twenty-five years, *Applied Categorical Structures* has been a principal forum for researchers and practitioners of category theory. With the encouragement of many colleagues, but in fact single-handedly, Robert Lowen created a scientific journal which, since the appearance of its first volume in 1993, has grown to become the leading international printed periodical centred around category theory and its applications. As its founding Editor-in-Chief, until his resignation in 2016, Bob oversaw the publication of twenty-four volumes of the journal, boasting some 750 articles, printed on more than 15,000 pages.
