



Correction to: Randomized Controlled Trial Evaluation of ABA Content on IQ Gains in Children with Autism

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The original version of this article unfortunately contained a few mistakes.

Table 1 contained three errors: Participants 3 and 14 mastered 4 and 10 programs; Participant 28 had a FSIQ change score of -4 . In the results section, descriptive statistics for the C-ABA group FSIQ change scores should read ($SD = 7.70$, range 5–23), and effect size for the C-ABA group relative to the control group was $d = 1.65$ and the C-ABA group relative to the T-ABA group was $d = 1.08$. The post-hoc test used in the ANCOVA is the Least Significant Difference (LSD) test. These errors do not change the conclusions or interpretations presented.

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
